You'll only hear English through our halls as we have a strict English Only policy to make sure students practice 100% while on campus.



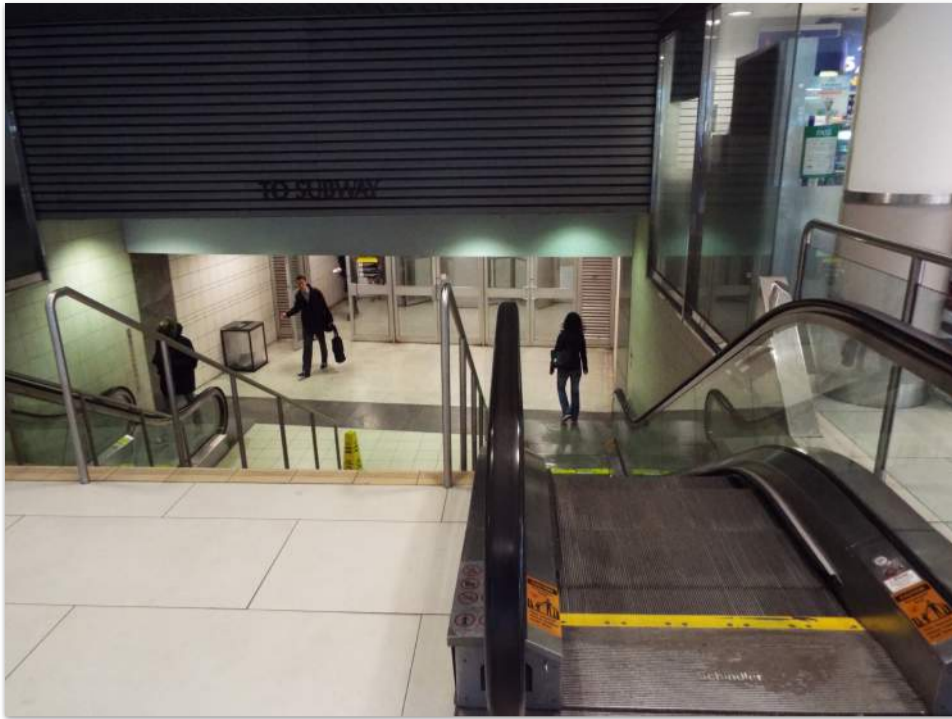
The average class size at Omnicom is 13-15 students with mixed nationalities.

The student kitchen has three microwaves, a refrigerator, sink, spring water and a pop machine available for use.

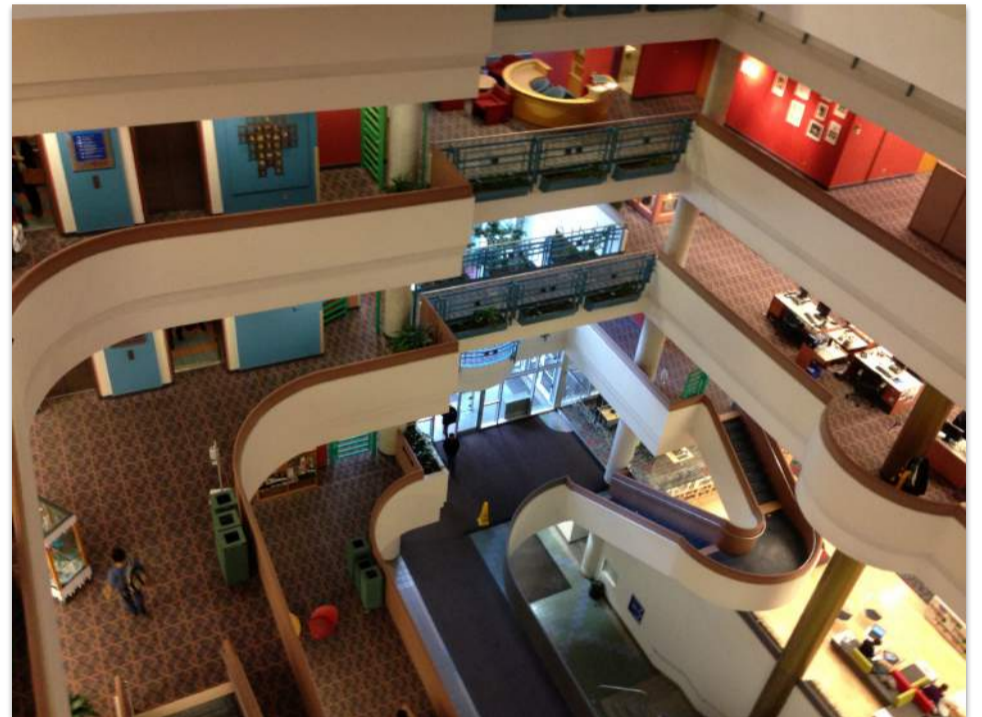




We are located directly above the North York Centre Station on the TTC Subway Line. You simply get off the subway, walk upstairs and you are in our building!

There is also a massive supermarket and it's all connected to the North York Centre, our home!

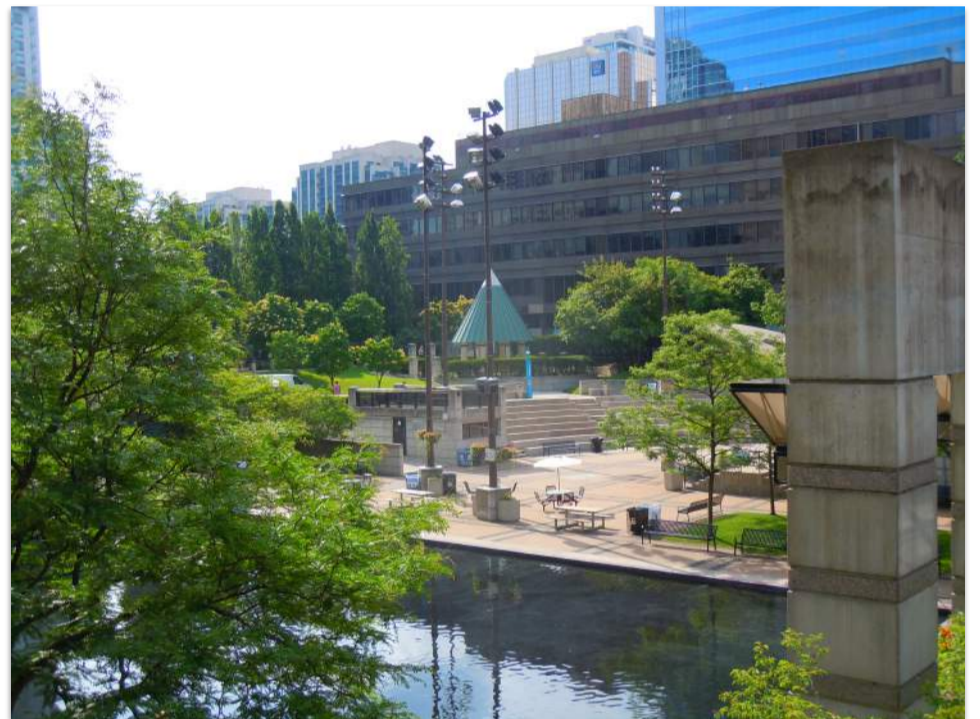
You can't visit Canada without going to Tim Hortons! There is one located less than 2 blocks south of our campus.
